Entrance of students is understood to be for the entire school year or for such portion of the year as may remain after date of entrance. It is fully understood that both the applicant and his parents or guardians hereby subscribe to all the rules and regulations of the school. The parent or guardian signing this application thereby obligates himself, or herself, for the payment of one year's tuition.

Bills for the year are payable at the beginning of the school year, but for the convenience of patrons the payment of half thereof may be deferred until the opening of the winter term.

This application should be accompanied by a deposit of ten dollars (\$10). If the application be accepted the deposit will be credited to the boy's account, and if the applicant fails to enter the school it will be forfeited. If the application be not accepted the deposit will be returned.
